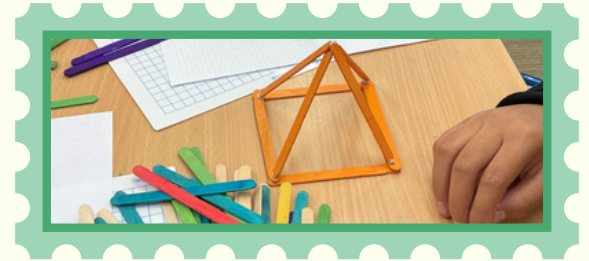


CLASSROOM NEWS - LN3

SUBJECTS

Maths:

Students are focusing on shape and angles and are building their addition strategies. They are engaging in problem solving tasks and are developing their ability to estimate.

Reading:

The students are reading different texts to build their vocabulary. They are continuing to improve their ability to read for longer periods of time. Students are reading a wide variety of texts and are exploring the author's point of view.

Investigations:

Australian History is our focus this term. Students are identifying and learning about the key moments in Australia's history. They are exploring the impacts of European Settlement through videos and real life stories. It's been great to see the enthusiasm and engagement from students during these lessons.

Positive Climate:

Our focus this term is team work. Students are learning to work with different peers to build their social and collaborative skills. There has also been a focus on kindness towards one another and the use of kind words.

Writing:

We are exploring information reports and biographies. Students are learning to identify key language features and explain the purpose of them in texts. They have been learning to improve bland sentences using descriptive words.
