## **Student Support Group Meetings**

Thank you to all of the parents and carers who attended the Student Support Group meetings .Our staff reported back that these meetings were very positive, and we appreciate your contributions because you are the expert on your child/ren and know them best.

These important meetings are a partnership between our school and our families and bring together everyone involved in a student's education to talk about their wellbeing and learning goals, discuss the adjustments that are needed to meet the child's needs and celebrate the achievements of the child.

Student Support Groups include the student's parent/s or carer/s, teacher and often another school staff member from the Wellbeing or Leadership teams. They can also include a support person for the parent, allied health workers who are involved with the student's care (such as an Occupational Therapist, Psychologist or Speech Therapist) and the student themselves (if appropriate). For our Koorie students, we also invite the input of our Koorie Educational Support Officer.

Student Support Group meetings are held for all students who are on the Program for Students with Disabilities (PSD), our Koorie students, as well as some students with additional needs. If your child has a disability or additional needs, you can ask the school for an SSG.

# Food Handling & Cooking Group





This semester, in partnership with *Banksia Garden*, we are delighted to introduce Colleen Coath as our instructor for Food Handling and Cooking. Participants will delve into topics including:

- Understanding food safety laws in Australia
- Techniques for preventing food poisoning
- Recognizing and fulfilling the roles and responsibilities of a food handler

Following these informative sessions, participants will have the opportunity to learn how to prepare a variety of lunch box-friendly recipes that are great to prepare at home. Colleen Coath brings not only expertise in food handling and cooking but also a wealth of experience as an English teacher, creating a welcoming and supportive environment for anyone interested in enhancing their English skills.

Food Handling & Cooking group is held every Wednesday, from 9.30am -12.00pm in the BVPS Kitchen.

#### **Gardening for Food Program**

During this autumn season, our focus will be on planting winter crops, enhancing soil quality through composting and worm farming, and doing some pruning activities. We'll also learn the process of growing plants from cuttings and seeds. If the weather is rainy, we'll head indoors for some garden-inspired activities. To conclude each session, members of the Gardening group will come together with the Cooking group to enjoy a meal. **Gardening programs is held every Wednesday from 9.30am -12.00pm at BVPS Garden**.

Saverplus is a free, life changing program to develop lifelong savings habits, gain financial skills. Participants who complete the program will get \$500 for an educational item!

There are 3 Elements of Saver Plus:

- 1. SAVING Work with a Savings Coach to work through your budget and develop a life-long savings habit
- 2. MONEY MINDED WORKSHOPS Learn to build money management skills and receive lots of resources. 5 X 2 hour workshops, each with a different theme.
- 3. CLAIMING ANZ bank will match what participants save up to \$50 a month to a total of \$500 over 10 months. On the 11th month of the program participants claim their matched funding.

This money is to be used on an educational tool such as a laptop or school camp for a child.

The Eligibility criteria:

- Have a Health Care Card or Concession Card AND receive a Centrelink Payment\*
- Be studying OR have a child in school (child can be starting next year)
- Have some regular income from work\*
- Be 18+ years old

\*Participant may also be the participant's partner.

BVPS Community Hub is looking for at least 10 participants to participate in the program to do the Money Minded Workshop on site. Zoom/online class options are also available.



Sibling photographs are by request and cannot be ordered after photo day.

#### **LATE ORDERS**

If you miss photo day, portrait and group packages can still be ordered online for 7 days afterwards with no late fees. After that time, late orders will require separate processing and handling and therefore will incur a \$15 late fee per package.

#### ONLINE ORDER RECEIPTS

An order receipt will be emailed to the email address you provide during the ordering process. Please note that orders placed via PayPal can take up to 48 hours for payment to be processed and a receipt sent.

#### ARE THERE FEES FOR ORDERING ONLINE?

# SPORTS/EXTRA-CURRICULAR PHOTOS

Once sports/extra curricular photographs have been taken, processed and made available for order online, your school will send you a link that you can use to place your order online. A 20% discount is applied to sports/co-curricular orders placed within the first 2-weeks. After the 2-week discount period, orders can still be placed online at our standard prices.
