Recipe

Fluffy Slime Recipe

Ingredients

- 2/3 Cup White Elmer's Glue
- 1/2 Teaspoon Baking Soda
- 1/4 Cups Shaving Cream
- 1.5 Tablespoons Contact Solution - MUST contain boric acid and sodium borate In Ingredients.
- Food Coloring

Instructions

1. Add white glue to a bowl
2. Add water and baking soda then mix
3. Add shaving cream then mix. The more shaving cream you add, the fluffier it will become.
4. Add food coloring until you are happy with the color.
5. Slowly add in the contact solution.
